Sines vs. Kessler Trial. Sines vs. Kessler is a groundbreaking federal lawsuit led by [Integrity First for America](#) (IFA) against neo-Nazis, white supremacists, and hate groups responsible for the Charlottesville violence, August 11-12, 2017. The jury trial is calendared for four weeks, with Judge Norman K. Moon presiding. Please pray for all involved in this trial as the plaintiffs seek accountability for the trauma and damage we all suffered on August 12, 2017.

In-Person Worship has resumed but the pandemic continues to impact our community and people who are unvaccinated, especially children under 12. Charlottesville has been classified as an area of Substantial Community Transmission by the CDC, prompting them to advise that everyone wear masks indoors in public. Therefore, our Church Council asks that everyone resume masking and social distancing in worship until community transmission subsides. Asking fully vaccinated members to mask does not negate the efficacy of the vaccine. Instead, it shows how we need to continue loving and protecting everyone, and helps prevent vaccinated people from spreading the highly-contagious Delta variant unknowingly. We continue to encourage everyone eligible to be vaccinated to get the shot. Please continue to stay home if you are sick. We will continue to offer worship online through Zoom and Facebook. Check www.hintonavenueumc.org for the latest details.

We prayerfully ask that you sustain your generosity so that Hinton Avenue can continue to be a blessing to others.
